

Bataplus



7 -12 years



2-4 players



36 cards



Aim of the game: To win all the cards.



How to play:



The cards are shuffled and dealt equally between the players.

The players stack the cards in their hands, face down. All players turn over their top card at the same time.

The player holding the highest card wins the trick.

However, the player holding the lowest card may decide to turn over a second card. In this case, all players turn over a further card. The players add together the two cards they have turned over and the player with the highest total wins all the cards in the trick.

Again, the player with the lowest total may decide to turn over a third card. Each player then adds up the three cards he has turned over and the player with the highest total wins all the cards in the trick.

Players place the cards they have won beneath their own stack of cards.

Sometimes, several players will have the same score: either the same value for the first card or the same total after two or three cards have been turned over. In this case, battle commences.

Each player places a new card, face down, above his card(s) then another card face up. The player with the highest card wins all the cards in the trick.

Winning:

The player who collects all the cards from the other players wins the game.
